

Lincoln Diocesan Guild of Church Bell Ringers Education Officer

The Lincoln Diocesan Guild of Church Bell Ringers wish to recruit an Education Officer to organise and coordinate the training and education of ringers. This is a new position and the person appointed will be required to lead the setting up of the office and creating a range of policies and activities to meet the Terms of Reference. The Education Officer will be a key member of the Guild Committee who will oversee the work of the new office.
