(For both absolute beginners and those with some experience)

Depending on demand and available helpers we shall be offering the following opportunities to develop your handbell ringing skills either from scratch or building upon prior knowledge and experience.

Absolute beginner. The operation of ringing a handbell in change ringing fashion explaining how hand and back stroke is rung. Ringing rounds in a rhythmic fashion. Plain hunt with a coursing pair (e.g. on six 1-2 or 5-6). Introduce Plain Bob (if you're very very good!)

Plain Bob and beyond. Revising Plain Bob with plain courses and short touches. Introducing Double and Reverse Bob and St Clements. Also on demand exploration of Kent TB and Cambridge Surprise Minor, Stedman Doubles.

Absolute beginners will be warmly welcomed. If you already have some experience of change ringing on handbells it would also be great to see you. You'll be able to both help others and also explore new methods for yourself. We anticipate two groups in operation.
