## **News from November:**

A half muffled QP was rung at Deeping St Nicholas in memory of those innocent victims of the Gaza Israel conflict. A QP of Yorkshire Royal was rung at Ewerby and was a 1<sup>st</sup> for Jo French. Over 20 members attended the branch meeting at Greatford with the majority enjoying a pub lunch afterwards. Methods ranged from PB Doubles to Greatford Surprise Minor.

**West Lindsey:** A QP of PBD was rung at Kirton Lindsey.
